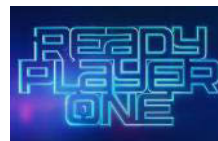

March 1

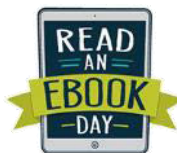
Pig Day

Want to take a picture? Pose for the camera and smile! Today we will read stories about kids who love to take pictures or be in pictures! We will also have several stand ups out for you to be

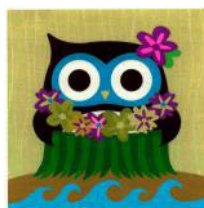


able to take all the photos you want today!

Did you know that sharing is caring? We all need to learn to share with our friends even when we would rather not. Come hear stories about other kids just like you who are learning to share everything from toys to best

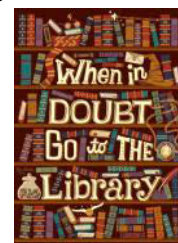


friends with others.

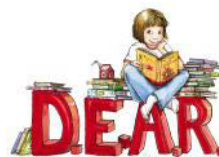
National Library Week
