Every child just wants a normal childhood. They want to have friends. They want to get through life without being embarrassed by their families. And most of all they want their houses to be



normal places they can escape reality and just be who they are.

This is not how things are working out for Lewis. He is having to move in with his Uncle Jonathan who he barely knows in a whole

new town. Once in the house, he learns that the house was built by an evil warlock and witch who has put a terrifying clock somewhere in the walls of the house. Why did they put the clock in the walls of the house? What will happen if it stops ticking? Can Lewis and his Uncle find the clock in time to stop whatever the evil witches have planned for their

little sleepy town?

The original book was published in 1973 but the story is still as thrilling today as it was then. Why not pick up a copy today to find out what happens before running to the theaters to watch a movie that has thrills, chills, magic, and a clock in it.

BRAINFUSE HELP NOW

The first day of school was August 20th. Does your student need help understanding their homework yet? Why not let the library's newest database help?



Brainfuse is a homework help website where students and tutors can meet in the Brainfuse Online Classroom. There tutors guide students through homework challenges and help them develop the necessary skills to complete assignments on their own. But that is just the beginning of what Brainfuse has to offer students and adults.

Brainfuse offers live skills tutoring and an extensive library of Brainfuse-created lessons and videos tutorials that can be accessed when the tutors are offline or if the student just needs a little more infor-

mation on the subject. There are games and quizzes that the student could customize by just uploading the list of words or material needed to be studied and then "play" their way into remembering it all. In addition, SkillSurfer contains hundreds of practice tests in a wide range of subjects. Along with the normal subjects, SkillSurfer offers practice test for tests such as:

- The new SAT
- ACT
- The new GED
- TASC (a GED alternative test)
- HiSet (a GED alternative test)
- GRE
- GMAT
- ASVAB

- TOEFL
- TOEIC
- US Citizenship Test Course: (including practice tests and lessons)
- College Placement Test Preparation: (COMPASS/ACCUPLACER)

Once the practice test is taken, the student can see what areas of the test they need help on and either use the online lessons and videos or access a tutor for more help.

Brainfuse also has a Writing Lab where a student can upload a paper they are writing to have the tutors look over it and given them suggestions on areas of their paper, including voice, fluency, organization, and word choice.
