NEW YEARS RESOLUTION: KEEP TRACK OF THE BOOKS YOU'VE READ FROM THE LIBRARY!

In the library's Online Catalog, select the link or button called "My Account."

A login page will appear and you will be asked for your 14 digit library barcode number and PIN (last name in lower case). Click the "Submit" button and you will be logged in to your account.

Once you have logged into your account, you will see your personal information. You will have tabs to allow you to check the number of items you have checked out, holds, and fines on the account.

Click the "My Info" tab. You will see the button "Preferences." Check the box that says "Show my Checkout History" and then click the "Update" button. From that point on, any items you check out will be listed in your personal reading history. Previously checked out items will not be listed. You may delete any or all items from the list at any time.

To see your reading history, check the "Checkouts" tab. You will see the "My Checkout History" button. Click on it to get a list of all items checked out since you activated your history.

Logout of your account when you are finished to be returned to the main search screen.

Please be aware that if you elect to keep a Reading History, under the USA Patriot Act, it may be subject to examination by law enforcement authorities without your permission.

These services are free to use with your library card.



Overdrive is an library service where you can check out eBooks and eAudiobooks from anywhere, anytime! Overdrive can be found on our website, or you can download the Libby app. Just choose HUGHES LIBRARY and sign in with your library card number. Your PIN will be your last name. Now you can search for eBooks and eAudiobooks and start reading! eBooks and eAudiobooks can be checked out for 2 weeks.



Hoopla is another library service where you can check out audiobooks, comics, eBooks, movies, music, and TV shows with your library card! "Sign Up" and follow the instructions. Enter your email and create a password, then select Marion & Ed Hughes Public Library as your library. Enter your library card number, and your PIN number will be your last name. You can now log in with your email and password anytime you like! You can pick any of the materials available. Titles are always available for checkout on Hoopla with no holds. Each library card is limited to 10 checkouts per month.

TRY INTERLIBRARY LOANS!

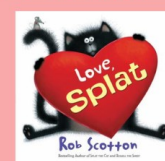
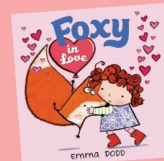
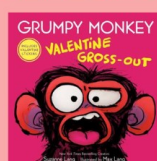
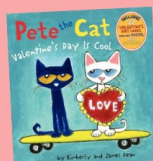
Interlibrary loans are when our library borrows a book from another library. You will need your library card number and a working phone number in order to request a book. It can take 1 to 6 weeks for an item to arrive.

Make an Interlibrary Loan request at the front desk or online!

Online: Go to the Nederland Library website (ned.lib.tx.us) and select the link "Interlibrary Loan" from the tool bar at the top of the page. Then check the Texas Group Catalog for the title of the book. When you find the edition of the book you need, click "Request Item" button and fill out the form that pops up.

In person: Simply request a form at the front desk and fill in the author's name and title of the book, along with your contact information.
